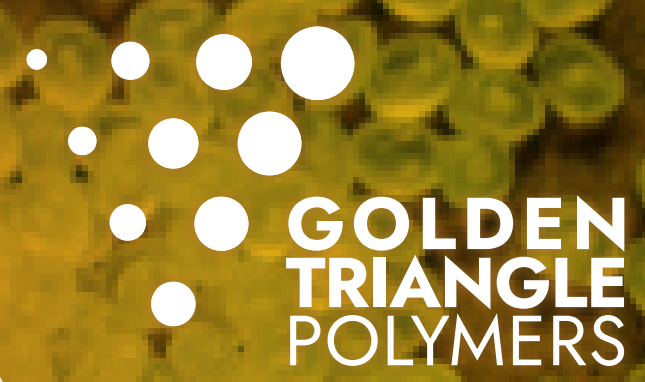


Road Improvements



GTPC is funding the road work and donating it to TxDOT. Once complete, TxDOT will manage the state-owned roads and associated improvements.



Road work will include addition of driveways and turn lanes, surface and median improvements, intersection reconfiguration, bridge work at Coon Bayou, and traffic signal modification at SH87 and FM1006.



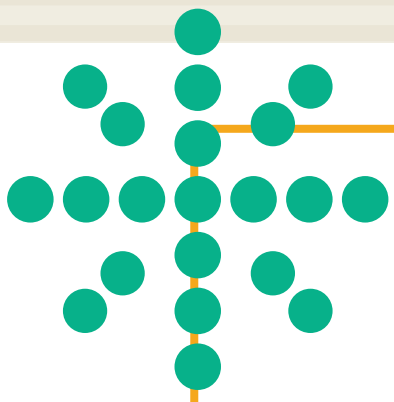
Purpose is to ensure safe passage for public traffic, craft labor, and over-sized, heavy equipment (heavy hauls) related to the project.



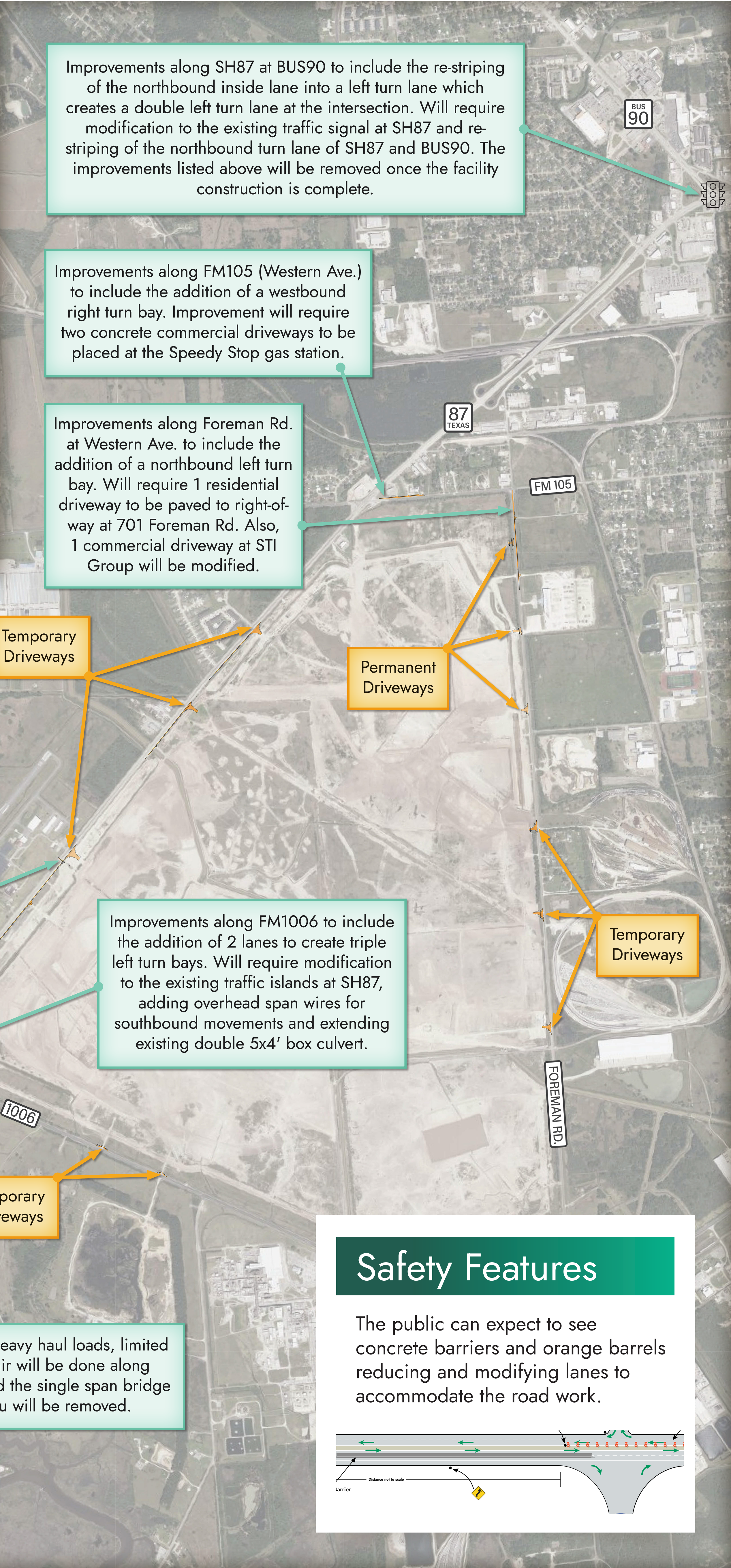
Road work began in April 2023 and will continue for approximately 10 months. Heavy hauls to begin in October 2023 for the next 20 months.



The craft labor force supporting this project is estimated at 4,500; however, road improvements have been developed to accommodate a 7,000-person work force.



Golden Triangle Polymers Company (GTPC) and TxDOT have an agreement that will allow certain improvements to be made to state-owned roadways in 2023.



Safety Features

The public can expect to see concrete barriers and orange barrels reducing and modifying lanes to accommodate the road work.
