

GTPC is funding the road work and donating it to TxDOT. Once complete, TxDOT will manage the state-owned roads and associated improvements.



Golden Triangle Polymers Company (GTPC) and TxDOT have an agreement that will allow certain improvements to be made to state-owned roadways in 2023.



Road work will include addition of driveways and turn lanes, surface and median improvements, intersection reconfiguration, bridge work at Coon Bayou, and traffic signal modification at SH87 and FM1006.



Purpose is to ensure safe passage for public traffic, craft labor, and oversized, heavy equipment (heavy hauls) related to the project.



Road work began in April 2023 and will continue for approximately 10 months. Heavy hauls to begin in October 2023 for the next 20 months.



The craft labor force supporting this project is estimated at 4,500; however, road improvements have been developed to accommodate a 7,000-person work force.

Improvements along SH87 at BUS90 to include the re-striping of the northbound inside lane into a left turn lane which creates a double left turn lane at the intersection. Will require modification to the existing traffic signal at SH87 and restriping of the northbound turn lane of SH87 and BUS90. The improvements listed above will be removed once the facility construction is complete.

Improvements along FM105 (Western Ave.) to include the addition of a westbound right turn bay. Improvement will require

Improvements along Foreman Rd. at Western Ave. to include the addition of a northbound left turn bay. Will require 1 residential driveway to be paved to right-ofway at 701 Foreman Rd. Also, 1 commercial driveway at STI Group will be modified.
